<u>Mar. 1</u>	#257 <u>DACY CLEARING</u>	<u>Pat Collier</u>
	The east side of Lake George provides some nice X-C ski runs. Once into Dacy Clearing, we can explore a few of them. Distance will be up to the group. Meet at the Warren County Municipal Center at 9:30 AM.	
<u>Mar. 8</u>	#258 <u>LONG AND ISLAND PONDS</u>	<u>Jean Spatny</u>
	Winter is a good time to enjoy these ponds by snowshoe or skis because the marsh areas (and beaver pond!) should be frozen. The distance is from 4 to 6 mi. depending on where we can park. Meet at the Warren Co. Municipal Center at 9:30 AM.	
<u>Mar 15</u>	#259 <u>THIRTEENTH LAKE</u>	<u>George Yager</u>
	Some nice trails on the east side of the lake. We'll probably go about 4 to 5 mi. Meet at Warren Co. Municipal Center at 9:30.	
<u>Mar 22</u>	#260 <u>CEDAR ROCK/MAPLE FARM</u>	<u>Elsie Poor</u>
	On the eastern slope of Bald Mt. in Arlington, Vt., this hike is part country road and part jeep trail - about 3 mi. round trip and some climbing with a view of the town and Green Mts. beyond. On the way back we'll stop at a small modern sugarhouse and museum. Meet at the Saratoga Mall parking lot in the corner by Montgomery Ward's at 9:30 AM.	
<u>Mar 29</u>	#261 <u>GLENS FALLS RESERVOIRS</u>	<u>Virginia Durso</u>
	Ginnie will lead us to one or more of the Glens Falls Reservoirs - Butler, Keenan or Wilkie Ponds. Meet at the Warren County Municipal Center at 9:30 AM.	

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<u>Apr. 5</u>	#262 <u>PEEBLES ISLAND/COHOES FALLS</u>	<u>Roger Menges</u>
An easy walk on an island near the junction of the Mohawk and Hudson Rivers near Cohoes. Views of swirling waters on all sides. Then we'll take a look at the Cohoes Falls from the Waterford side and continue on a trail along the Mohawk. Meet at the Grand Union in Clifton Park by Northway Exit 9E at 9:30.		
<u>Apr 12</u>	#263 <u>MERCK FOREST</u>	<u>Irv Boyle</u>
A hike in a beautiful park in Vermont with lovely views and trails. If conditions permit us to drive to the parking area so that we don't have to walk in, Irv will take us up to Antone Mt. Meet at first bridge across the Hudson River on RT 29 east out of Schuylerville at 9:30 AM.		
<u>Apr 19</u>	#264 <u>CRANE POND FROM THE NORTH</u>	<u>Edythe Robbins</u>
The trail guide describes the beginning of this as "a walk along a true wilderness trail through a forest of stately proportions". It is 2.8 mi. one way to the pond. Meet at the Warren Co. Municipal Center at 9:30 AM.		
<u>Apr 26</u>	#265 <u>COBBLE MT./CLIFFORD FALLS</u>	<u>Pat Collier</u>
A wonderful little mountain with great views and a grand waterfall - an unbeatable combination. They are located a bit beyond Keene - a 1.2 mi. round trip for Cobble Mt. and 0.5 mi. round trip to the falls. Meet at the Warren Co. Municipal Center at 9:30 AM.
